

In Talk with Md. Mahmudul Kabir

Executive Director – Sales and Marketing



The real estate industry plays a pivotal role not only for the developer companies but also for the homebuyers as well as the country's overall economic growth. What do you think of the current real estate market in Bangladesh?

country compared to neighboring countries. In our country, it is around 14%-16% whereas in other SAARC countries, it is 4%-7%. Also, although currently home loan interest rate is low, it may increase. This will again dampen the real estate market, so initiatives have to be taken so that it can be maintained at a steady rate.

Another challenge infesting the real estate market is the presence of subpar real estate companies who compromise with quality and service, and this damages the reputation of the entire industry. In this case, REHAB can play a more active role so that customers can put their trust in the sector.

bti recently launched The Platinum Collection, can you tell us what sets this Collection apart?

6 Ways to Promote Wellness at your Home




Go green

For example, turn your balcony into a small outdoor retreat with potted plants and a chair or two. Hanging plants or large plants acts greatly as screens and gives you privacy. Also keep small vases with plants like money plant or succulents to

Tackle noise pollution

Celebrating Corporate Summit 2018






