1. The pandemic causes the housing rent to plummet in Dhaka

Date : 18th June 2020

The current conditions have had a significant effect on the home renting situation of Dhaka. According to a survey done by BRAC, low-income families had to face the brunt of it. In comparison to February, where 62% suffered a loss of jobs in low-income families, 95% suffered a loss of income. As a result, an exodus occurred for a significant portion of them as they went back to their home towns.

The situation caused the rents to increase, but a lack of income in most families rendered them unable to pay their landlords. The latter are being affected by the situation too, as they search for tenants to rent out their empty homes but are unable to do so. All the expenses related to vacant homes are now on the shoulders of the landlord; some have been forced to reduce the rent in fear of losing the few tenants they have left.

2. Safety measures being taken all over the country

Date : 22nd June 2020

Safety measures are being strengthened all around the country not only in professional settings but at homes too. Landlords and tenants alike have set up low-cost solutions like bleach soaked shoe rugs and disinfection of the person and any goods brought from outside by sanitizer sprays as anyone enters the building. These practices are becoming mandatory for entrance as it only takes one unaware carrier to accidentally infect everyone in the building.

All of this still comes at a cost, so cooperation from authorities and the community alike is required. As both homeowners and tenants keep footing the bill for this process it is important to keep in mind that continuing like this could only add to current the list of problems. Necessary materials need to allocate to the communities by the relevant authorities, especially high-risk areas, in order to help with these measures taken. To overcome this situation, cooperation and coordination are essential.

3. The government allows the use of untaxed money in the housing sector

Date : 25th June 2020

To save the industry from a vulnerable time, the government has announced measures to save the real estate industry by allowing the whitening of 'black money' for the upcoming fiscal year of 2020-2021. REHAB had previously urged the government to take this initiative to keep the industry afloat due to the recent shift in the economy.

Individuals can now utilize their untaxed money to invest in real estate given they provide a 10% tax on their purchase. Any previously undisclosed property can be legalized by registering and paying tax at a certain rate per square meter of the asset. This was done to stimulate the economy, improve tax collection, and decrease unemployment.

4. Domestic gas connections to be readily available again

Date : 1st July 2020

The government has decided to supply piped gas connections to residential areas after almost a decade-long suspension. According to recent discussions, the government has recommended domestic piped gas connections to households in big cities. The current use of LPG(liquefied petroleum gas) has been deemed more expensive. Instead, the proposed LNG(liquefied natural gas) is 65% more cost-effective and comparatively safe for use than LPG.

This means households, both new and old, that don't have a piped gas connection yet may soon get one.

5. Government decreases registration fees for land and apartments

Date : 2nd July 2020

The real estate sector in Bangladesh has felt the brunt of the hit the economy took. To help alleviate some of the pressure, the government has decided to reduce the registration fees that may help the companies stimulate the buyers to make a purchase. The amount is reduced to as much as 10% in comparison to the previous 14%, meaning a buyer would have to pay Tk10lakhs instead of Tk14lakhs on a Tk1 crore acquisition of land or flat.

This payment will include registration fees, stamp duty, VAT, and local government tax. REHAB is hopeful this decision will help turn the sector around even in the current situation.
