I am the new COO (Chief Operating Officer). I started my career as a teacher, whose life took a turn and got into the business world. I was at the University of Asia Pacific for a while after which I went for my post graduation in Finland. Upon my return I started working in the engineering sector in Grameenphone and Nokia and then moved to sales while in Nokia. That's how I got into the business side of the company. Afterwards I worked in Rahimafrooz, where I honed my marketing & sales leadership skills. I worked at RANCON for a while before deciding to join here at bti. All through this, I loved seeing my efforts bear fruit for the business. That has been my one and only passion.

How will your varied experience help you at bti?

My accumulated experience throughout my career has given me the opportunity to learn facet of business operations. The 7 years I spent at Nokia not only helped me build my sales skills from scratch but also has groomed me to comply with ethical and moral practices of business. Do you have any plans you mean to implement?

Keeping the virus out of your home

It's been over almost 2 months since our quarantined lives started. By now we have adhered ourselves to routine and spend the time adjusting to the situation. While we all know how to prevent contracting the virus (through social distancing) out in public. We should also take a look into how to keep the virus out of our homes and our families safe.

Maintaining Personal Hygiene

This is the most important and effective way to stay safe. This would definitely include the basics like washing our hands for 20 seconds minimum, keeping hands away from MEN (mouth, eyes and nose). Additionally, we should also practice using a tissue while sneezing or coughing and properly disposing it. In the event where a tissue is unavailable we will use our elbow to cover our noses.

If anyone at home displays the aforementioned symptoms,we need to stay at least 3ft away from them. They need to be isolated and treated accordingly. Proper personal hygiene is imperative to maintain our families' health and of those around us.

Keeping clothes clean

We should exercise caution when it comes to clothing. It is advisable to remove shoes as we enter our homes, taking a shower and changing into clean clothes. The used clothes should be washed immediately with warm water and detergent. The same goes for bed sheets and towels. Clothes may transmit the virus through the air if shaken, so it is best if we put them straight into water. We also need to make sure to disinfect the laundry basket, and it would be easier to store laundry in disposable bags that can be discarded after use. For the time being, we can try and finish our laundry at home.

Keeping our homes disinfected

We need to thoroughly clean around the house to make sure there are no fomites. Fomites are objects /surfaces that are most likely to carry infectious microbes. Surfaces that we are most likely to come into contact with need to be disinfected regularly to reduce the chances of infection. We need to make sure the rooms are well ventilated and wear gloves while cleaning.

Among the surfaces we touch regularly are door handles, kitchen surfaces, tables, switches, chairs, cellphones, etc. To clean such surfaces, we need to use bleach solutions to disinfectant afterwards. We can also use detergents diluted in water for that purpose. We need to follow proper instructions before cleaning the surfaces. It is equally important to clean the corners of your house to make sure to prevent a dengue outbreak as well by throwing out any water that may have been sitting for a while. Dark corners and stagnant water often serve as breeding grounds for the mosquitoes.

Properly cooking and handling food

While there has yet to be a case of someone catching the virus from food, it's best to practice caution. The surface of the packaging can serve as a fomite and there is a risk that arises from ordering food from outside. If at all possible, we need to stick to home cooked meals in clean utensils, dispose of expired foods, store and cook them at appropriate temperatures. If outside food is ordered, takeout containers disinfect them before unpacking the food and discard immediately after use. Hands need to be washed both before and after the meal.

An all Around Fruitful Investment


If we are not convinced enough, we could still ask, why real
