DHAKA'S HOUSE RENT RISES Almost 30% in five years, 5% After pandemic exodus

Official records reveal that Dhaka housing rents grew roughly 5% even after the pandemic virus forced many city people to flee. Rents in the city have risen by 29% in the previous five years, making life difficult for those on a tight budget. According to a new Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) report, the Covid-19 epidemic hasn't stopped rent increases in Dhaka, which increased roughly 5% between June 2020 and June 2021. The poll also indicated that between FY 2018 and FY 2021, national rents increased by 21%-26%. Their research shows that housing rent in Dhaka consumes up to half of certain medium and lower-income groups' income. An FE study indicated that the average annual increase in rent in the city was 5.71 percent, whereas the national increase was around 4.25 percent. In Dhaka, as well as throughout the nation, the FE research indicated that lower-middle and middle-income groups saw larger rent increases than higher-income ones. According to the Consumers Association of Bangladesh (CAB) Chairman Dr Ghulam Rahman, the CAB conducted a modest study on Dhaka housing rent and discovered an 8%-9% rise. The rising rents have put a huge strain on the middle and lower classes. Dr Rahman proposes that the government develop public housing for the city's impoverished, lower-middle, and middle-income residents. Dr Mujeri, a former Board member of the BIDS, believes the government should apply strong rent control laws to make housing accessible to everybody (BIDS). The economist asked the government to publicize the laws and regulations to educate both customers and homeowners.

RIU TO HOST WEBINAR ON DHAKA REAL ESTATE MARKET

On November 10, the London-based Research Intelligence Unit (RIU) will offer a webinar on real estate trends and possibilities in Dhaka. This webinar will address the residential property market from a buyer's viewpoint, including the main and secondary markets, as well as rental yields. Dhaka has been identified as a city with enormous potential for real estate growth in the coming decade by the RIU national report on Bangladesh. Also covered in this webinar are the trends and possibilities for local and international developers to thrive in the residential, leisure, and commercial real estate sectors over the next decade. Sir Peter Heap, former senior British diplomat and President of British Sri Lanka and Maldives Forum for Business and Trade, will be present. Roshan Madawela, founder and CEO of the UK-based organization with a growing presence in Asia, will moderate the panel. From luxury and semi-luxury apartments to commercial real estate, hotels, and bare land, the RIU research illustrates Dhaka's expanding real estate sector. On the other hand, the research forecasts growth corridors based on changing consumer demand patterns and big infrastructure projects. Rising income levels pushed by a period of continuous high GDP growth rates are one of the major contributing elements to Dhaka's residential real estate market's consistent rise. For house purchasers, investors, and developers alike, the research and planned webinar provide fresh insight on a sector struggling to obtain unbiased and credible data and information. REALTORS CALL FOR Amending proposed Dhaka building Construction rules

The planned rules and regulations to decrease the height and scale of buildings in the capital and its environs have been met with resistance by real estate agents, who want them amended.Proposed DAP 2016-2035 limiting building heights is "absolutely unrealistic," Alamgir said in an interview. President of the Bangladesh Real Estate and Housing Association (REHAB) remarked during a news conference in a major hotel Sunday. For both consumers and companies alike, the cost of constructing an apartment in Bangladesh is expected to rise significantly under the Dhaka Building Construction Rules-2021. Only 9,000 square feet would be allowed to be built in a comparable structure, according to the proposed restrictions. Additional restrictions include no more than a third of a storey on the side of a road less than 20 feet long. The president of REHAB stated, "It will exacerbate the crisis, and purchasers will be harmed." Dhaka city's land prices are quite expensive at the moment. The cost of a flat or apartment will double if the maximum eight-storey residential structure is built on the land acquired at this high price. Building construction regulations 2021 suggested by Shamsul Alamin must be substantially revised in order for affordable rents and a place to live to be maintained in the capital, he added. "We expect that the proposals of planners, architects, specialist experts, and stakeholders will be finalized in DAP 2016-2035 and the Building Construction Rules 2021." Asked by reporters, Kamal Mahmud stated that planned cities are being created in most nations of the globe with such a plan in mind.
