

INTERIOR DESIGN MARKET CATCHES LIGHT, MORE WANT SMART HOMES

The domestic interior decoration market currently stands at Tk20,000 crore, which is projected to double by next five years. The market for home interiors and renovation in Bangladesh is growing fast on the back of a booming real estate market, rising income levels of people, and urbanisation. Experts have attributed the sharp rise in demand for interior design services to people's increasing inclination towards smart homes and commercial spaces amid the influence of social media, and changes in their living standards and lifestyle.

The interior decoration in Bangladesh got a touch of modernity in the 1990s and it has been growing steadily ever since. Around 7 lakh people are currently employed in this sector. Industry insiders said at one time the interiors of buildings were decorated using local and foreign wood. Then various artificial wooden boards and plastic sheets were used. These are still used. But, in addition, the virtual reality technology using 3D printing papers or boards imported from different countries, CAD technology, 3D photos, virtual reality, SketchUp, V-Ray, and 3D Max software have been interior designing to a new level. Countless themes, such as the Mediterranean Style, the European Style, and the Ethnic Indian Style of Design and Decor are getting common nowadays. Now almost 90% of apartments that are being constructed by realtors in the capital have their interiors decorated.

IFC BRAC BANK PARTNER TO LAUNCH BANGLADESH'S FIRST EVER HOUSING BOND

Thousands of low and middle-income urban and rural families in Bangladesh, often underserved by commercial banks, are expected to be able to take out affordable housing loans through IFC's investment in the country's first housing bond to be issued by BRAC Bank. In a first for the country, IFC will make a subscription of up to \$50 million-equivalent Bangladeshi taka (BDT) denominated, five-year senior bond by BRAC Bank to fund and expand its affordable housing finance program. The move is expected to create thousands of new jobs in construction and related industries. It's estimated about 80 percent of people in Bangladesh's cities live in rented properties all their lives, mostly due to lack of mortgage finance.

Home mortgages only account for three percent of the loan market in Bangladesh, below the average of 4.9 percent in South Asia and 8.9 percent in emerging markets. Most financial institutions focus on providing housing finance to the higher-income people, while access to formal housing loans for low and middle-income segments is very limited. This causes a surplus in premium housing and a shortage of both housing finance and housing units for low and middle-income people. It is the first time that a foreign investor plans to invest in an onshore local currency bond to be issued by a local private institution to finance housing. It then demonstrates opportunities for new foreign and local investors to invest in such thematic bonds in the domestic corporate bond market," said Allen Forlemu, IFC Regional Industry Director, Financial Institutions Group, Asia and Pacific.

CAA ROBERT MATHEW LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD 2022

Bangladeshi Architect Rafiq Azam has won the Commonwealth Association of Architects (CAA) Robert Mathew Life Time Achievement Award for 2022. A five-member jury board including architects Saif Ul Haque (Asia), Professor Alfred Omenya (Africa), Jonathan Mizzi (Europe), Liz Walsh (Oceania) and Jennifer Smith (America) unanimously named Rafiq Azam as the winner of the CAA Robert Mathew Award 2022, said the Institute of Architects Bangladesh. The Robert Mathew Award recognises innovative contributions to the development of architecture in the Commonwealth context. The award is to be made to an architectural practice making the most outstanding contribution, having particular relevance to the country or region in which the architect or architectural practice operates. This award is given to Architects to acknowledge Life Time Achievement.



CONDOMINIUMS: A WAY TO SPACIOUS LIVING

The number of condominiums – complexes of buildings containing individually owned apartments – across the country has been increasing constantly over the past two decades. Affluent buyers love these complexes as they leave a significant portion of the project area for open space. According to the Real Estate and Housing Association of Bangladesh (REHAB), developers have built 184 condominium projects in the last 16 years across the country, which can accommodate about five lakh people. The highest number of condominiums are in Dhaka (80), Chattogram (34), and Sylhet (14). REHAB President Alamgir Shamsul Alamin (Kajal) mentioned that about Tk2 lakh crore has been invested in these condominiums. REHAB Director Naimul Hassan told TBS that many of these projects are called "city within a city" as they provide all the necessary civic amenities inside their boundary. Apartments in the condominium projects. It is mainly businessmen, politicians, bureaucrats and expatriates who buy and live in these luxury apartments, said people involved in this sector.

There are two types of apartments in the condominium projects in the capital – luxury and ordinary. One of the real estate developers said luxury apartments in the condominiums cost around Tk15-25 crore while ordinary ones cost around Tk1-5 crore, depending on the areas they are located in. Housing companies have recently undertaken new condominium projects in different areas of the city, including Mirpur, Mohammadpur, Rampura, Malibagh and Kanchpur, as they are becoming increasingly popular. Some companies are building three condominiums simultaneously. According to the Rajdhani Unnayan Kartipakkha (Rajuk), real estate developers have submitted applications for seven more condominiums in the capital. Around Tk20,000 crore will be invested in these projects.
